IV. NEW BUSINESS

1. Chairman Meehan reports that budget approval will take place in October/November.
2. Commissioner Umlauf reports that recently a new ordinance was put on the books for consolidated waste efforts. The village has added dumpsters for this effort. However, Shock Park still has dumpsters in view from the Prairie Path. This is because businesses already have a 5 year dumpster lease. Chairman Meehan would like to add this to next month's agenda. He adds perhaps we could plant bushes in that area to hide the dumpsters from the Train and Prairie Path view. He asks the EC to bring feedback/ideas to the next meeting.

V. OLD BUSINESS

A. Advisory/Development

1. CBD Streetscape – No report
2. Development Project Environmental Checklist – Chairman Meehan reports that he and Commissioner Abeln are working on this. They will be considering adding Solar to this checklist and are also looking at what the GRC has to offer.
3. The Taylor Street Pedestrian Tunnel – Chairman Meehan reports that a letter was sent to CPA and our comments were well received. CPA is going to go over our comments with the artist. The artist will come back to us with new drawings. Chairman Meehan adds that he and Commissioners Malone and Gregory have discussed fundraising ideas and will discuss more at next month's meeting.
4. Taylor Street Sustainable Landscaping – Commissioner Umlauf reports that she is waiting to hear back from Engineer Daubert and asks that this item be removed from the agenda going forward.

B. Education

1. Residents Seminars – Chairman Meehan would like to talk more about this at next month's meeting.
2. Sustainable Garden Tour– Commissioner Umlauf reports that Commissioner Truitt is putting together a recap for the next steps for 2020. We would like to offer this for the weekend after July 4th. Once the date is picked we can get people to commit. Chairman Meehan adds Commissioner Truitt wanted to add a line item in our budget for this. He will go back to Assistant Village Manager Holmer and give an estimate for the garden tour so we can get it in our budget for next year. A budget of \$1,000 for the Garden Tour would allow us to fund this event
