This meeting will be conducted by audio and video conference without a physically present quorum of the Commission because of a disaster declaration related to COVID-19 and public health concerns affecting the Village of Glen Ellyn. The Illinois General Assembly passed Senate Bill 2135 on May 23, 2020, which was signed by the Governor on June 12, 2020. Senate Bill 2135 (now Public Act 1010640) amends the Open Meetings Act and allows the Village Board and Commissions to participate electronically in Board and Commission meetings when it is not feasible due to a disaster such as COVID-19. The Chairperson has determined that an in person meeting at the Police Department is not practical or prudent because of the disaster. Physical attendance at the Police Department by the public is also not feasible because of the disaster. The Police Department Liaison will be in attendance at the Police Department in compliance with the Act.
