1) 2026 Budget Discussion - Other Funds

Village Manager Franz introduced the agenda for the discussion.

Finance Director Brankin began in more detail by stating the following funds would be reviewed: Government, Propriety/Enterprise, Capital Projects, Internal Services, and Police Pension. He then reviewed the remaining agenda for budget approval.

Throughout the review process, the Board asked questions for clarification, as Finance Director Brankin reviewed each fund. Department heads also contributed to answering the Board’s questions and concerns.

Trustee Christiansen asked about the Fire Services Fund, specifically EMS services. Fire Chief Clark replied. Discussion ensued.

Fire Chief Clark reviewed the proposed 2026 budget for the Volunteer Fire Company. The Board asked questions during his presentation, which Fire Chief Clark answered.

Finance Director Brankin continued his review of funds with TIF districts.

Norris Eber, resident and public representative of a group he named the Roosevelt Road Committee, gave his thoughts on the Roosevelt Road TIF.

General Manager Allen then reviewed the Village Links and Reserve 22 mission and budget. He replied to all questions from the Board.

Finance Director Brankin then continued with the review of the funds, ending with the Police Pension.

There was then an open discussion on miscellaneous budget items. The Board expressed appreciation of Finance Director Brankin's clear presentation of the budget.
