I. CALL TO ORDER

The **February 20, 2018** regular meeting of the Environmental Commission was called to order at **7:34 PM** at the Village of Glen Ellyn, Civic Center, 535 Duane Street, Glen Ellyn, Illinois by Chairman Kreuzer.

II. PUBLIC COMMENTS –None.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM January 16, 2017 MEETING – Approved

IV. ANNOUNCEMENTS – Commissioner Gregory announces that Staff Liaison Cabrera has received a fellowship to continue her education from the ICMA. The EC board congratulates Cabrera on her accomplishment.

V. NEW BUSINESS

1. *Tree Plan*-Chairman Kreuzer reports that we would like to encourage the village and residents to plant trees. Park District Liaison Frigo suggests contacting Jennifer Brown to see what her plan is with regard to tree planting. Chairman Kreuzer asks Commissioner Ryan to head up the tree plan and set up a meeting within the next few weeks to discuss partnering up with the Native Plant/Tree sale and the Conservation Foundation. Commissioner Crawford adds that he would like to be a part of the group working on the Tree Plan. Park District Liaison Frigo reports that the Native Plant/Tree sale is scheduled for September 29th. The Conservation Foundation is running the sale and will be selling 5 gallon size trees and shrubs that are native to our region for \$30. The best location for tree and plant pickup will be at Sunset pool. The sale will be publicized via the village through the Conservation Foundation. All orders will be pre-ordered by a specific date.
2. *Dark Skies Certification* – Chairman Kreuzer reports that he attended Andrew Van Gorp's presentation on the Cool DuPage County Dark Skies initiative. They would like to obtain a county wide Dark Skies certification. Chairman Kreuzer would like the EC to promote a Dark Skies week. Commissioner Malone adds that it would be nice if we could make this a community event. Chairman Kreuzer suggests moving Dark Skies to HWT subcommittee and asks HWT to come up with an action plan.
3. *River Sweep* – Park District Liaison Frigo reports the DuPage County River Sweep will take place on May 19th from 9:00 am-Noon at the Churchill Woods Forest Preserve. Chairman Kreuzer asks the EC board to bring their families and all take part in this event. Commissioner Zelasco motions to Proclaim that May 19, 2018 to be the DuPage County River Sweep Day. Commissioner Malone seconds the motion.

4. Park District Earth Day Participation – Park District Liaison Frigo reports that Earth Day will take place on April 22 from 1:00-4:00. We are promoting this event as Celebrate Lake Ellyn Park on earth day. We are inviting residents to picnic in the park. There will be kids activities and several booths set up from various presenters. Chairman Kreuzer adds that the EC will have a booth at this event promoting and informing residents of our various initiatives.

VI. OLD BUSINESS

A. Arts & Art Reach Subcommittee Report, Adrienne Gregory.

1. GE Fund Status Report – Commissioner Malone reports that is a meeting this Thursday with the Rotary Club to educate them on the GE Fund. There is also a breakfast meeting on March 23 at 7:30 am with various fund advisors and financial planners at 7:30 am at Glen Oak Country Club.
2. Dark Windows – Commissioner Gregory reports that large posters have been made to promote the One Earth film festival and will be put up where we have dark windows. Rich Nicolls has also donated face icons which we can print up and put up where there are dark windows.
3. Sign Ordinance/Murals- Commissioner Gregory reports that we are looking at funding options at the local, state and federal levels for the tube mural.
4. The Tube-Chairman Kreuzer reports that this project is not yet approved by the village.
5. One Earth- Commissioner Gregory asks the EC board to buy tickets and attend this event. The EC is sponsoring After the Spill which will be shown on March 8th. There will be tables set up prior to the start of the movie from Scarce and Sustain DuPage. The EC will also have a table promoting our initiatives.

B. Sustainable Landscaping Subcommittee Report – Jennifer Umlauf

1. Spring Newsletter – No report.
2. Monthly Videos/E-Blasts-Chairman Kreuzer reports that the third monthly video will be on recycling. Staff Liaison Cabrera adds that the One Earth video is done and Nix Six video will be completed in the next 2 weeks.

C. Health, Wellness, Transportation Subcommittee Report – John Zelasco

1. Zagstar –Staff Liaison Cabrera reports we have met with Northwestern Medicine and they have agreed to be a big sponsor of this project.

2. Habitat Restore Recycling – Commissioner Zelasco reports that he did find another non for profit recycler but they would not come out to Glen Ellyn. He suggests putting together a pamphlet in the packet listing what can be recycled and reused. Staff Liaison Cabrera confirmed that a pamphlet for the Habitat Restore is in the works and will be done before she leaves.
3. Coal Tar Resolution- Commissioner Zelasco reports that Bill Holmer has said the village does not use Coal Tar. Commissioner Zelasco adds perhaps when can include a pamphlet in the water bill explaining to residents the effects of using Coal Tar on the environment. Chairman Kreuzer asks Staff Liaison Cabrera if she could find out how we would go about adding this pamphlet to the water bills.
4. Mooring Resolution – Commissioner Zelasco reports we are still waiting on this.
5. Recycling Extravaganza – Commissioner Zelasco reports that he has contacted all vendors who will be participating at this event. He is still looking into paper shredding for this event and is following up with the vendor. He also adds that #6 Styrofoam will be collected as well. He will bring the collection over to Dart. A list of what type of Styrofoam will be collected is being put together. He also will be getting posters made to advertise this event. Chairman Kreuzer adds going forward we may want to add funding for this event so we can offer paper shredding. Chairman Kreuzer asks the EC board to attend this event. He also asks Staff Liaison Cabrera to help in setting up this event and assist in gathering the various departments that usually take part. (ie: Public Works, Police, etc.). Staff Liaison Cabrera states she will do all she can to help.

D. Energy Sustainability/Recycle Subcommittee Report, Jeff Abeln

1. 2018 Cool DuPage Initiative: Commissioner Abeln reports that he will be having a meeting tomorrow with Joy.
2. Groot Decal and Clean Sweep – We are still waiting on the decal.
